# Cameroon

The **Eglise Evangélique du Cameroun** offered a training in climate change energy auditing, small business development and entrepreneurship for approximately forty youth leaders from at least four districts of Douala.





# Tansania

In Tansania 400 young people from **Karagwe diocese** participated in a seminar about climate change knowledge. Other activities were a 5 km walk for climate, a presentation of environmental friendly projects and the planting and distributing of 6000 trees.
